

POLICY ON CONSUMPTION OF FOOD IN THE LIBRARY

The consumption of food and beverages is not permitted in the reading rooms and other public areas in the library. This rule is necessary in order to protect library materials, furniture, and carpeting from damage. Patrons who ignore this rule will be asked to leave the library.

Exceptions to the policy on consumption of food and beverages can only be made in advance by the Library Board and/or Library Administration.
